
Mosaic Week 1 of Prayer
"the soul of the city"

Take some time and read Acts 1:12-15. This takes place after Jesus ascended into heaven following the resurrection. The church, at that point made up of 120 people, went back to the upper room.

Look at verse 14. **"All of these were constantly devoting themselves to prayer together."** There were four basic divisions - gender, race, geography and theology - but now men and women were together. Go to Acts 2:1; "When the day of Pentecost did come . . ." Pentecost was the day that God gave his Spirit ". They were all together in one place." Unity makes the way for the out-pouring of Pentecost. In verses five and nine, there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven, showing diversity of people. Look at verse 11; there were even Jews and Arabs.

One Soul : Michael Slaughter states, "All who believed were of one heart. Which means we share a common life source and one soul.

Soul is your identity. Everyone has a unique soul, a unique identity. It's your personality. It's that part of you that will always be you for eternity. Your soul is your life force that is going to live even when your body doesn't live. What every person who believes in Jesus Christ has together is a common identity. There is a word or expression that is used for believers, we are the body of Christ."

There is a story told of a quiet security guard with the lonely job of waving cars into and out of a local technology business. He read a book about God being present everywhere and decided to whisper a little prayer-nothing more-for everyone who passes his gate. In a short time he had people (who knew nothing of what he had been up to) now rolling down their windows to say "Hi." Soon, brief exchanges started. He asked the appropriate people (as the Spirit led) if they wanted prayer. Immediately the answers to prayer started to roll in.

Wow, A life that became swept up into something larger and greater than himself, into God's purposes for the world. A calling to participate in God's saving purpose and plans for the world.

The gospel calls into existence churches whose fundamental identity is that of a people called to participate in God's mission, caught up into a reality greater than themselves, invited to bear witness to the world of a new way of being human in God's presence.
